# 2021... Starting over - Well, kind of..

Bridges had a lot of adversity in 2020. Key leadership transitions and COVID in many ways changed the landscape of Bridges. We felt that God was pruning us back for rebirth (Bridges 2.0). In many ways 2021 felt like the first year of Bridges in 2005. Many new beginnings, forming a strong foundation and developing new staff and ministries guided most of our time in 2021. God used 2021 to help us simplify, focus, equip and disciple:

- Our vision became crystal clear- To bridge people to Christ and make disciples that make disciples.
- Instead of praying for strategy, prayer and listening to God became our strategy.
- God sent us several new staff who are willing to become disciples and make disciples. (Two of them are past Bridges students!)
- Summer and after-school programs flourished, mentoring was rebooted and has grown significantly and Bridges Homes (housing counseling and home ownership) was born. Specifically, dozens of students are being discipled, over 75 mentors have been trained to go into local elementary schools and Bridges flipped its first home while providing housing counseling to eight families.

Bridges was fruitful in 2021 because of Jesus Christ and we believe He has positioned us to do even greater things in the Kingdom with Him in 2022!!
